- In 2006 Celina's Park System hosted over 109,000 participants and spectators at Park Events
- Celina Parks System is made up of five parks with a total of over 124 acres
- Bryson Pool is one of the best pools in the area that boasts of having 9750 square feet of water surface, 150' slide, zero depth easy access, three diving boards, and youth slides. It also has a separate baby pool with plenty of area for patrons to spread out and enjoy.
- Celina has a new state of the art artificial Baseball Field that is the first of its kind in Northwest Ohio. The \$250,000 complex was made possible by the generous donation from the Don and Bill Montgomery Family and the Celina Insurance Group.

YOUR PARK SYSTEM

EASTVIEW PARK 51 ACRES WITH:

Located on Grand Lake Rd. (may also enter from end of East Livingston Street) this park has 7 Baseball/Softball Fields—8 Dugouts—4 Batting Cages — 2 Press Boxes and 3 Concession Stands—3 Football Fields—4 Shelter Houses—3 Restroom Facilities— An 11 acre Pond with a Beach Area and Volleyball site— Playground Equipment— 1 Basketball Court—Walking Path and 2 Maintenance Buildings

WESTVIEW PARK 51 ACRES WITH:

Located on Fairground Rd. (May also enter from intersection of Jill Ave. and Hierholzer St.) this parks boasts of 3 Baseball /Softball Fields—1 Press Box and 2 Concession Stands—7 Soccer Fields—2 Tennis Courts—2 Sets of Playground Equipment—1 Shelter House with Restroom— 2 Acre Pond and a Nature Preserve with 15.6 acres—Walking Path

LAKESHORE PARK 5 ACRES WITH:

(Formerly Northshore Park -Hawk Property) At the intersection of Main Street, Lake Shore Drive and South Ash Street this park includes 3/4 Mile of Shore Line—15 Courtesy Docks including a Boat Docking Ramp—3 Shelter Houses—1 Restroom — One area designated to the Music In the Park Event with a Stage under Tent—Plenty of picnic area to enjoy the Lake View.

MERCELINA PARK:

East of Lakeshore Park between Lake Shore Dr. and Warren Streets this park offers Baseball/Softball Field—Playground Equipment—10 Rental Docks—Boat Ramp—Restrooms—Basketball Court— 2 Shelter Houses—Concession Stand

PULLMAN BAY PARK 2 ACRES WITH:

East of Mercelina Park on Lake Shore Dr. this Park offers a Shelter House—Restroom Facility and a set of Playground Equipment.

BRYSON POOL 2 ACRES WITH:

Located at the corner of Market and Riley Street. 9,750 Square feet of Water Surface—8 Competitive Lanes—a Rain Drop Structure— a 150' Water Slide —2 (1 Meter) Diving Boards and 1 (3 Meter) Diving Board—2 Baby Slides—Wading Pool and a Zero Depth Access Area—2 Youth Slides- 1 Basket House/Maintenance Building.
