

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The City of Celina will receive sealed bids for the Lakeshore Drive Boat Dock Facilities Project. The project consists of approximately 475 lineal feet of shoreline improvements along Lakeshore Drive of Grand Lake on the south side of the City of Celina.

Bids will be received at the City of Celina, 426 W. Market Street, Celina, Ohio 45822 until 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 14, 2009 at which time and place bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids received after 11:00 a.m. local time will be returned unopened.

Bids must be signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, sealed in the provided envelope, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

Attention of Bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, and various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for a payment bond and performance bond for 100% of the contract price.

The Bidding Documents may be examined and/or obtained at the City of Celina Engineering Department, 426 W. Market Street, Celina, Ohio 45822. Construction plans are available for viewing online at www.celinaohio.org. Bidders must obtain a copy of the bid documents from the Engineering Department for \$25.00 for each complete set of documents. Non-refundable checks are to be payable to the City of Celina.

The Owner reserves the right to reject each and every bid and to waive informalities, irregularities, and errors in the bidding to the extent permitted by law.

No bidder may withdraw their bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
